# DISTRIBUTED LEARNING COURSES

### Courses are offered partially on-site and in an interactive format

Distributed learning courses other than telecourses require students to meet on campus for 50% of scheduled classes. The remaining time will be spent by students accessing course material, engaging in learning activities or interacting through the instructional management system. Telecourses identified as distributed learning courses may require students to meet on campus at times announced by the instructor. Students taking a distributed learning course will need access to a computer, e-mail, the World Wide Web and various computer software. These requirements may not necessarily be listed in the schedule of classes.

Telecourses provide a convenient, flexible way to earn college credits in the comfort of your home. You can choose to set your own study schedule with lessons on videocassette tapes or watch lessons on cable television.

Telecourses include weekly assignments, textbook and study guide readings, and easy access to instructors by phone or e-mail. Convenient exam schedules are a plus for busy students juggling job and family responsibilities. Some courses may require on-campus class sessions. 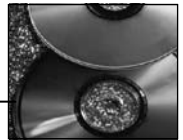

## ONLINE COURSES

Access expanded offerings right from your home!

Delaware Tech online courses are a learning option for independent, self-motivated students. They are for students who have little time to come on campus for courses or who have travel constraints. They are of the same quality and rigor as on-campus courses. They are most appropriate for you if you are self-directed and have at least moderate computer skills. You will need access to a computer and an Internet provider. Suggested minimum hardware/software requirements are a 56 bps modem, Pentium II processor, 32 megs of RAM, standard version of a word processor, up-to-date virus protection program, and course software. Students are responsible for having all the required hardware/software prior to class.

Online courses are instructor-led courses (not self-paced) delivered entirely in a password-protected, Web-based format. They include a course Web page, instructor and student e-mail, and discussion sessions. Instructors post the course work, including assignments, to the course Web page. Students participate in electronic discussions and complete assignments. Testing is offered online or at approved sites.

Students will access their online courses through the college Blackboard (<http://edge.dtcc.edu>), using their college e-mail user-name and password.
