

COLLEGE NAME AND SEAL

College Name: The formal name of the college is **Delaware Technical & Community College**. Always use the ampersand (&) in the name – never use the word “and.”

In written materials, the first reference to the college should use the formal name; “Delaware Tech” can be used for subsequent references. **DO NOT USE** Del Tech, DE Tech, DTCC or DT&CC. These forms of reference are not acceptable.

 Georgetown – Jack F. Owens Campus (formal); Owens Campus (informal)
 Stanton and Wilmington – Stanton/Wilmington Campus
