

What to bring:

Lunch: Each camper will need to bring or buy a lunch, snack and drink. Refrigeration is provided if you bring lunch.

Athletic wear: Each camper participates in athletics and may want to bring sneakers and a hat for outdoor activities.

Sunscreen: Outdoor activities are scheduled regularly. Please bring a hat and/or sunscreen for your child.

Early Dismissal:

If a camper needs to leave early, please send a note stating the time of departure and who will be responsible for camper sign out. The person responsible for picking up the camper will need to report to the camp staff and asked to provide identification. Anyone not providing identification will not be permitted to take the camper off the grounds until a parent is contacted by telephone. Due to the nature of our field trips, we do not permit early dismissals during field trips. Students must be picked up by 12:30 pm, prior to field trip departure. We appreciate your cooperation.

Cancellations/Refunds:

Refund: Deposits are non-refundable. If your child is unable to attend camp in which he/she HAS enrolled, you may request a refund for the remaining balance paid from Corporate and Community Programs. All requests must be received in writing 72 hours prior to the first day of the camp week for which your child is enrolled via U.S. mail, fax or email. For partial refund requests to be considered, you must speak to camp office representatives only. Please note that refunds for payments made by check may take a minimum of six weeks to process.

Transfer Policy: If your child is unable to attend a camp in which he/she is enrolled, you may request a transfer to another camp week within the same camp season. All requests must be received in writing via U.S. mail, fax or email and must be received 72 hours prior to the first day of the camp week for which your child is enrolled. Any camp transfer which may occur will not be considered for partial refund at a later date.

Parking/Drop Off:

DTCC offers plenty of parking in designated student lots. No parking is permitted in loading zones.

Medicine:

All medications need to be given to the camp coordinator upon arrival. A medical form authorizing staff to administer medication must be completed. All prescription medications must be in original pharmacy containers labeled with name of patient, date prescription was filled, pharmacy phone number, name of medication, dosage, and schedule for taking, prescribing doctor and expiration date of medicine.

Field Trip Reminders

- All campers, ages 5-15, go on afternoon field trips.
- **Bring socks** for bowling on Monday, for ice skating on Tuesdays and roller skating on Wednesdays. Some parents send a jacket for ice skating. Skates are included; inline skates are an extra fee.
- **Towel & Bathing Suit** on Thursday
- **Sunblock & maybe a hat** on Friday for outdoor field trips to parks, outdoor museums, gardens, nature centers and much more!

Sign-In/Sign-Out:

All campers must be escorted by parents or guardians into the main lobby and signed in with our camp staff between 8:45 and 9 a.m. Late arrivals should check in at the CCP office. Any camper arriving before 8:45 a.m. and/or not picked up by 4 p.m. will be assigned to our extended day program and a fee of \$10 per child will be due at the time of drop-off and/or pick-up.

The Top FAQ's About Camp

Will my child go on a field trip?

Everyone goes on field trips everyday. All campers participate in afternoon recreational camps everyday. For field trip information see page 3.

What if I need to pick up my child early from camp?

If your child has to leave early, please pick them up by 12:30 pm on campus. There are no pick ups allowed during field trips. Due to the nature of our field trips (ex. walking tours, hikes) we cannot arrange pick ups while a camper is on a field trip.

When should I register for camp?

Registration begins February 2nd with final payment required by 4:30 pm on the Wednesday prior to each week's camp start date. Registration is on a first come, first served basis.

Do I need to make a deposit to register?

Yes, a non-refundable deposit of \$50 per child, per week is due with your application. Pre-registration is required.

Does the camp day include an extended care program?

Yes, the extended care program begins at 7:30 a.m. and ends at 6 p.m. The fee is \$30 per week.

Will there be any additional fees?

All camp activity fees are included in the cost. Additional fees are charged only if you utilize the extended care program.

Will I be able to bring my own equipment?

The camp will provide all the equipment you will need unless specified. Please do not bring your personal equipment to camp. It is also recommended that campers leave personal electronic devices and cell phones at home.

Do I need to bring my lunch?

You may bring a lunch and Delaware Tech will provide refrigeration. You may also purchase food in the college cafeteria. The cafeteria does offer prepaid plans available on Monday mornings, first day of camp throughout the summer.

How should I dress for camp?

Come dressed to participate in athletic and artistic activities. Wear sneakers, not flip-flops!

Who works on the camp staff?

Our staff is comprised of teachers, counselors and college students from the local area.

What is the counselor/camper ratio?

We follow state guidelines for counselor/camper ratio. Therefore, 9- to 12-year-olds will have a 1/10 ratio; 7- to 8-year-olds will have a 1/9 ratio; and 5- to 6-year-olds will have a 1/5 ratio.

What if the camp I want is full?

Your name will be placed on our waiting list. You will be notified no later than the Thursday before the camp begins if a spot becomes available.

Safety & Discipline:

Campers will be notified of the safety rules on the first day of camp.

Campers will be reminded to make safe choices when necessary, and will be responsible for the decisions they make. Please do not send a sick child to camp.

Discipline problems will be handled in the following manner;

1. Individual behavior problems will be handled by the counselors.
2. If problems persist, the camper will be referred to the camp manager and the parents will be notified.
3. If problem continues to exist, the campers will be dismissed from camp and will not be permitted to return.

Refunds will not be granted if campers are dismissed from camp. Automatic dismissal from camp may occur at the camp coordinator's discretion.
