Student Enrichment Coordinators will visit the participants monthly during the academic year. Services include tutoring, PSAT/ACT & SAT preparation and fee waivers. College, financial aid and scholarship information will be provided to all Upward Bound Math Science students.

## WHAT IS THE UPWARD BOUND MATH SCIENCE PROGRAM



Upward Bound Math Science is a U.S. Department of Education program which addresses the achievement gap that exists in our country in the areas of mathematics and science.

The Federal program provides grants to projects designed to give participants the skills and motivation necessary to complete secondary education and to enter and succeed in post-secondary education.



## UPWARD BOUND MATH SCIENCE AT DELAWARE TECH

The program provides a six-week academic component of intensive instruction in math and science.



The academic year includes academic advisement, aca-

demically support skills learning, tutoring, follow-up, and mentoring. The participants must meet



the Department Of Education's requirements, display above average abilities and have demonstrated an interest or talent in math or science. The program is free to participants and their families.

The program has a three-fold purpose:

1. To academically prepare students to enroll in higher level high school math & science courses and graduate high school having maintained that level.
2. To enroll in higher level math and science courses in college.
3. To graduate college with a degree in math or science.

## HOW TO APPLY

Mail a completed application no later than March 14th.

Submit:

- Two letters of recommendation, one from a math or science teacher & one from a school guidance counselor.
- An essay stating plans, goals, and how Upward Bound Math Science can help you achieve your goals.
- A current report card, transcript, and State testing scores
