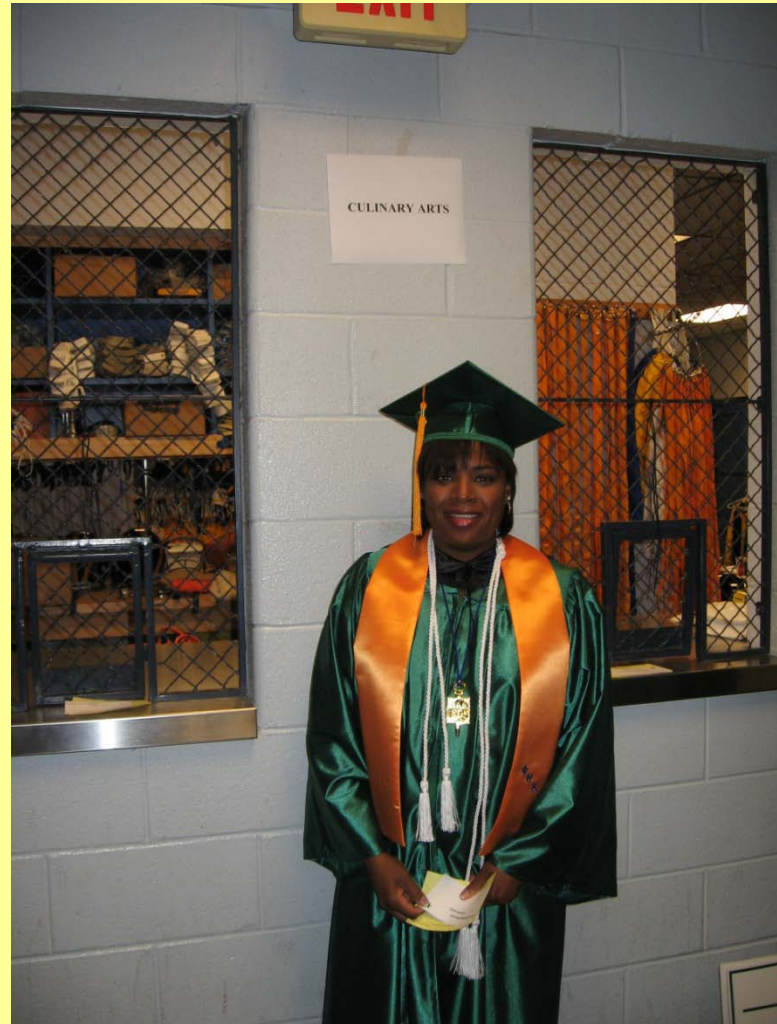
Qualifications to Join

Officers

- President
- Vice President of Leadership
- Vice President of Service
- Vice President of Fellowship
- Vice President of Communications
- SGA Representative (2 + alternate)

President:

- Runs the meetings
- Writes the agendas for the meetings
- Oversees all projects
- Keeps in contact with the advisors
- Speaks at the Induction Ceremony

Vice President Of Leadership:

- Runs the meetings if the President cannot
- In charge of all leadership projects
- Keeps in contact with the advisors
- Speaks at the Induction Ceremony
- (usually the VP of Leadership will advance into the President position once the President resigns or graduates)

Vice President Of Service:

- Runs the meetings if President and VP of Leadership cannot
- In charge of all service projects
- May need to contact people in the community
- Keeps in contact with the advisors
- Speaks at the Induction Ceremony

Vice President Of Fellowship:

- Greets members and takes attendance at the meetings (pass around sign-in sheet)
- Gets refreshments for the induction ceremony
- Brings & Returns materials for the meetings/inductions from the Advisor's office (bag of stuff)
- Keeps in contact with the advisors
- Speaks at the Induction Ceremony

Vice President Of Communication:

- Records the minutes at the meetings
- Makes posters, memos, or other forms of communication, as needed
- Keeps in contact with the advisors
- Speaks at the Induction Ceremony

SGA Representative:

SGA = Student Government Association

- Attends **ALL** SGA meetings (1st and 3rd Thursday of each month at 11:30 in Students Services Conference Room)
- Contacts the alternate SGA representative to cover for them in case of an emergency
- Turns in PTK minutes (and gets the person receiving the minutes to sign that they did indeed receive the minutes)
- Keeps in contact with the advisors
- Helps at the Induction Ceremony
