## **THE CONNECTED DEGREE 2 + 2 CURRICULUM**

Delaware Tech's associate degree program in Criminal Justice provides career education for employment or career advancement in public and private, criminal justice organizations. Graduates are prepared to practice careers in law enforcement and related services, corrections, counseling and case management. In addition the program provides students the foundation for transfer to public and private institutions to complete the requirements for a bachelor's degree.

Strayer University's Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice provides students with the theoretical, legal and operational aspects of criminal justice. Students acquire fundamental (as well as practical and professional) skills in all areas of criminal justice. Graduates are prepared for a variety of positions in the public and private sector including law enforcement, corrections, homeland security, private security, and juvenile justice.
