

Delaware Tech Radiology Students Win Top Honors at TechniBowl



Wilmington, DE—On March 29, 2010, students from Delaware Technical & Community College Radiologic Technology Program—developed and operated in partnership with Christiana Care Health System—competed in the 39th annual *TechniBowl* in Philadelphia. Team members **Kelly Nahodil** and **Sean Lanan** competed with teams from 16 regional technology schools, including 4-year institutions, to earn first prize in the rigorous competition.

The *Technibowl* is sponsored by the Philadelphia Society of Radiologic Technologists and is similar to television's *CollegeBowl* academic challenge. Student pairs participate in several rounds of competition, responding to questions about radiation physics, radiation protection and biology, radiographic procedures and patient care. As first-place finishers, Nahodil and Lanan received \$300 and a commemorative plaque which will be displayed on campus.

“Kelly and Sean were well-prepared, acted as true health care professionals, and represented the very best of Delaware Tech,” stated radiologic technology program coordinator Teri Foy. “It was a great accomplishment and a great day for all of us.”

Also included in the Philadelphia Society Student Day activities was the annual T-shirt contest. Delaware Tech senior student **Joe Hassett** won first place for his entry in the *most specialized*

category. The Philadelphia Society of Radiologic Technologists will use his design for future fundraising endeavors.

All three students will graduate from Delaware Tech this spring. Recognized for its focused and rigorous allied health curricula, Delaware Tech is the only state institution to offer a degree program in radiologic technology. Its graduates are prepared for high-demand positions at hospitals and healthcare organizations across the region.
