

H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS FOR STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is recommending that organizations do whatever they can to help their employees get vaccinated for the H1N1 flu virus because while the second wave of the H1N1 flu virus is waning, history has shown that pandemics can experience a third wave in the spring that could result in more deaths and serious illness.

Now is a great time to get the H1N1 vaccine since not as many people are currently getting sick, and the vaccine is plentiful. The College is holding H1N1 flu vaccine clinics at each campus for the convenience of students and employees.

The cost for the administration of the vaccine is \$15, payable in cash or check made out to DTCC. Regular full-time and temporary full-time employees over 9 months who have not used their Wellness Dollars in FY10 (July 1, 2009 - Present) may use this benefit for the H1N1 vaccination.
