## Associate to Bachelor's TRANSFER OPTIONS

**Connected Degrees:** Delaware Tech has established agreements with four-year colleges and universities that connect Delaware Tech's associate degree programs with bachelor's degree programs to create transfer opportunities. These connected degree programs offer clear and economical pathways for Delaware Tech graduates in specified areas of study to continue their educational achievement. You can graduate with an associate degree, be accepted at the partner institution, and transfer as a junior!

**Transfer of Credit:** Delaware Tech also has an agreement with the two other Delaware public higher education institutions (Delaware State University and the University of Delaware) that provides for transfer of individual courses as determined by the receiving institution.

**Dual Admission:** Special partnerships allow qualified Connected Degree students to gain admission to both Delaware Tech and a participating four-year institution simultaneously. Dual admission benefits include: transfer of Delaware Tech credits, locking in of bachelor's degree requirements during students' first year at Delaware Tech, academic advisement provided by senior institution available at Delaware Tech campuses, and priority pre-registration for students' first semester at the senior institution.
