Purpose

A preference is given to students that are Delaware residents but students that are non-Delaware residents are eligible to apply

The type and amount of aid shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation. The goal of the fund is to provide scholarships up to \$3,500.00 at each of the three institutes of higher learning.
