Delaware Tech has established agreements with four-year colleges and universities that connect Delaware Tech associate degree programs with bachelor's degree programs to create smooth transfer opportunities for you. These Connected Degree programs enable you to complete your associate degree transfer as a junior.

THE CONNECTED DEGREE 2 + 2 CURRICULUM

Delaware Tech's associate degree program in Business Administration, Accounting Option, provides students with information technology, communication, core accounting, and business, as well as general education courses to prepare them for entry-level technical and professional careers in industry, in local, state, and federal government, and in public accounting. Courses taken meet the education requirement to sit for the CPA Examination in the State of Delaware. Additionally, students are prepared to continue their education at the baccalaureate level.

Goldey-Beacom's Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Accounting Concentration, is designed to prepare students for positions of leadership and responsibility in industry, government, and public accounting. The Accounting program emphasizes computer skills, written, and verbal communications, as well as accounting theory and the most recent FASB pronouncements. Courses taken meet the education requirement to sit for the CPA Examination in the State of Delaware. Successful students also are prepared to continue in business programs at the graduate level.
