## **THE CONNECTED DEGREE 2 + 2 CURRICULUM**

Delaware Tech's associate degree program in Business Administration, Accounting Option, provides students with information technology, communication, core accounting, and business, as well as general education courses to prepare them for entry-level technical and professional careers in industry, in local, state, and federal government, and in public accounting. Courses taken meet the education requirement to sit for the CPA Examination in the State of Delaware. Additionally, students are prepared to continue their education at the baccalaureate level.

The principal objectives of Strayer University's Bachelor of Science in Accounting program are to provide students with a broad, fundamental knowledge of the field and to prepare students for employment in accounting careers. Students may allow him/her to prepare for professional goals, such as Certified Public Accountant (CPA), Certified Managerial Accountant (CMA), or Accredited Business Accountant (ABA).
