## **THE CONNECTED DEGREE 2 + 2 CURRICULUM**

Delaware Tech's associate degree program in Business Administration Technology: Business Administration Option provides students with a broad mix of business and general education courses intended to maximize transferability to baccalaureate institutions. Along with their core business courses, students take quantitative, analytical, and computer technology courses designed to enhance their critical thinking and decision-making skills in preparation for further study in business disciplines or for entry-level positions.

Delaware State University's Bachelor of Science in Management educates students to be future leaders and managers in a changing global environment. The general management concentration aims to develop in its students the intellectual and personal attributes that will enable them to compete effectively for positions in government, non-profit, and business organizations.
