1. Evaluate the capabilities and limitations of the most common network interface cards, cables, wiring plans, topologies, server hardware and operating system software. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13)

3. Plan, configure and install a dedicated file server and workstations LAN, and perform network maintenance. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
4. Plan, configure and install one or more peer-to-peer LANs and perform network maintenance for each. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
5. Plan, configure and integrate two or more LANs. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
