The student will be able to:

1. Develop knowledge of general Local Area Network (LAN) concepts including protocols, topologies, different types of servers and network operating systems. (CCC 5, 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
2. Set up user workstation environments on dedicated or peer-to-peer LANs. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
3. Set up and implement resource sharing, network menu or Windows, modems/faxes or CD-ROM on a LAN. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
4. Create security for individual or group access to a network and use network utilities to manage network operation. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
5. Configure and install third-party software on dedicated or peer-to-peer network. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
6. Design and implement a backup and disaster recovery plan for any LAN. (CCC 6; PGC 6, 11, 13, 14)
