

**NLN PRE-ADMISSION EXAM – RN & PN
2009 FALL SEMESTER**

You must be a Delaware Tech student to take this exam.
You may retest after a 6-month waiting period.

Seating is limited – register early. Allow 4 hours to complete the exam.

Registration Procedure:

1. Complete an application for the NLN Pre-Admission, which you may obtain from the Corporate & Community Programs Office (CCP), Nursing Department secretary, advisor or counselor.
2. Pay the \$55 fee by check (made out to DTCC), credit card, or cash when you register in the Corporate Training Center, Room 412. You must register in person and you must present a picture ID and proof that you are a DTCC student. Office hours are: Monday – Thursday, 8:00am-5:30pm; Friday, 8:00am-4:30pm.
3. **NOTE: You must present a picture ID and your DTCC student ID # to enter the test. Please arrive at the test location (Corporate Training Center, Room 412) at least 15 minutes prior to the start time. No one will be admitted after the test begins.**
4. Cancellation policy: Your cancellation notification must be received by the CCP office at least 72 hours prior to the test.
5. Test dates are the Tuesday or Thursday of each month. **You must apply & pay for test one week prior to testing (see testing/final application dates on back). Minimum enrollment of 8 students is required for each test section. In the event test section minimum enrollment is not met, students will be notified and placed in the next available section. Notification will be made within 24 hours after the final date for registration/payment.**

FAQ'S

What is tested on the exam?

Both examinations consist of three timed, one-hour sections of multiple choice questions (see subject descriptions below). Each question has only one answer. There is no penalty for guessing, but no credit will be given for any questions for which you mark more than one answer. **Please allow a total of 4 hours to complete the exam.**

- ❖ **Verbal skills and reading comprehension** – assesses word knowledge through sentence completion and reading comprehension.
- ❖ **Mathematics** – assesses arithmetic (integers, fractions, decimals, and percentages) and basic algebraic and geometric skills. Calculators are **NOT** permitted. Paper is provided.
- ❖ **Science** – assesses knowledge of general science, biology, human anatomy and physiology, chemistry, and physics.

Can I retake the NLN – Pre-Admission Exam for my major?

You can retake the NLN Pre-Admission Exam for your major (PN or ADN) after six months.

Can I use my RN Pre-Admission scores if I decide to change my major to the LPN program?

Yes.

What can I do to prepare for the examinations?

The National League for Nursing authors review guides for both the RN and PN Pre-Admission Exams, *Review Guide for the RN Pre-Entrance Exam* and *Review Guide for the LPN/LVN Pre-Entrance Exam*. These books are published by Jones and Bartlett and are available in the Terry Campus Bookstore at a cost of \$32.95. One copy of each of these test prep books is available for review in the Terry Campus Library and in the Assessment/Career Center.
