Terry Campus Opens Registration for Youth Summer Campus

DOVER- Are you worried your kids will spend another summer just sitting in front of the television or playing video games? Exercise their minds and bodies by enrolling them in Youth Summer Camps at Delaware Technical & Community College, Terry Campus. Registration is now underway.

Kids ages 6 to 13 can get excited about 34 camps that will cater to a variety of interests including Adventure, Arts, Sports & Fitness and IQ-Builder categories. And parents can get excited that most of the camps are educational.

Your child will continue to participate in fresh challenges that keep their summer stimulating because over half of the camps offered are new for 2007. "Cookin' Kids" is a new camp that will teach kids about food and cooking in Terry Campus's brand new Culinary Arts full-functioning professional kitchen. "Rockin' Rockets" will teach kids about rocket science, space travel and will even lead the participants in a real miniature rocket launch. Just like the television show, "The Apprentice" will teach participants what it takes to start and run a business by practicing sales, marketing and leadership skills. Other new camps include focuses on stargazing, pirates, babysitting and more.

Participants enroll in camps for one week, three hours a day or for the whole day. Many kids enjoy the experience so much that they enroll for multiple camps. Last year,

over 650 kids enrolled and many attended more than one camp. Popular camps from previous years are still available including the “Young Actor’s Workshop”, “TV Production” and Crime Scene Investigation (“CSI Camp”). Sports camps such as soccer, tennis and now lacrosse are also available.

Child care is offered before and after scheduled sessions for camp participants.
