Act quickly to apply for Terry Campus scholarships

DOVER- If you think a lack of money is standing between you and a college education, think again.

The Delaware Technical & Community College, Terry Campus has numerous scholarships for which students can apply. A full list of scholarships and requirements may be picked up at the Financial Aid Office on campus and viewed at www.dtcc.edu/terry/scholarships.

As the fall semester rapidly approaches, now is the time to apply for financial assistance. Interested parties should act quickly as scholarships will be awarded once an adequate pool of applicants is received.

There is a scholarship for everyone; from single parents to future business professionals, from recent high school graduates to adult learners. Scholarships are available for full-time and part-time students.

For example, the Starkey Scholarship will financially support a single parent working to gain an education at the Terry Campus. Eligible applicants may be full or part-time students that have graduated from a high school in Delaware or have obtained a GED.

Students who plan to study business or agriculture may apply for the Wallace Family Scholarship which will award recipients \$500 a semester. To be eligible, applicants must be a Smyrna High School graduate or resident of the Smyrna-Clayton area.

The Terry Campus will also award two eligible students in the entrepreneurship associate degree program up to \$625 per semester thanks to a donation by the Roy Klein Education Foundation. The entrepreneurship program teaches students how to transform innovative ideas into commercial products and services and how to create and maintain a private business.

The foundation's mission is to create financial support for education and economic development in Kent County thus honoring Klein as a visionary who constantly worked to develop a flourishing community that offers the best in education and employment opportunities.

Depending upon individual scholarship guidelines, awarded funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, supplies, transportation or childcare.

Perspective and returning students must submit a completed FASFA form and scholarship application at the Financial Aid Office in the Terry Building or on the web to be eligible for any scholarships.
