With over nine years of training and coaching experience, this Dover High alumnus is no stranger to the game, or to teaching it. During his four years of goalkeeping on the Rowan University men's soccer team, he helped the team claim the New Jersey Athletic Conference Championship twice, and was a designated member of the 2000 National Collegiate Athletic Association District III Runner-Up Team.
