Terry Campus Continues Increased Enrollment Trend

DOVER- Delaware Technical & Community College, Terry Campus is continuing its trend of increased enrollment. The 2008 spring semester is the highest spring semester enrollment in the history of the campus.

As of Monday, student registration reached 2,946 and the number will continue to climb as students sign up for classes that start later in the semester. Last year's spring semester enrollment topped off at 2,745.

College Vice President and Campus Director Daniel L. Simpson said extra-curricular activities and first-rate instruction make a difference when students are deciding where to attend college. "I think students who enroll here see the diverse opportunities the campus provides. Varsity sports, clubs and a drumline all compliment an excellent educational experience," he said.
