Hawks lacrosse players ranked in top ten

DOVER- Four of Delaware Tech's lacrosse players are ranked in the top ten nationally with National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA).

The Delaware Tech men's squad are 3 and 1 for wins so far this season with #24 attack/midfielder Scott Brozey leading the way ranked as number 1 in the country for goals scored (18 goals) according to NJCAA. Brozey is a freshman at the Terry Campus in Dover and is in good company as 3 of his team mates are also ranked in the top ten. Sophomore Tyler Fry with 10 goals, freshman Brynn Weidenmann with 9 goals and sophomore Nate Gorski with 9 goals are ranked by the NJCAA as #5, #7 and #9 respectively.

According to the team's coach, John Coveleski, this team is putting Delaware Tech's program on the map. Other NJCAA teams are learning that although the Hawks athletic program is young, these guys are showing a competitive spirit that wins.
