Terry Campus commencement ceremony

DOVER- The Delaware Technical & Community College, Terry Campus thirty-seventh annual commencement will take place today, Monday, May 11 at 6 p.m. on the campus mall area between the Educational and Technology Building and the Terry Building.

This is the second year the graduation ceremony will be held on campus since 1986. Hosting the event outdoors allows adequate space for the large number of graduates and their guests. The number of students earning degrees at the Terry Campus has increased, resembling the rise in student enrollment. This year the campus has topped its record of 329 graduates with 344 degrees or certificates being awarded. The oldest graduate this year is 61 years old and the youngest is 19 years old. Those receiving honors are historically high as well with 53 being recognized as Suma Cum Laude, 53 Magna Cum Laude and 65 Cum Laude.

The 2009 commencement speaker is Ann Shepard Visalli, Director of the Office of Management and Budget (OMB). Director Visalli was appointed January 21, 2009 by Governor Jack Markell to serve during one of the most historic budget deficits in Delaware's history.

The commencement ceremony will be held rain or shine. In case of severe weather, the event will take place in the Education and Technology Building's Conference Center.

All guests must present a ticket for admittance.
