Hawks men's lacrosse team top seed in Region 19

DOVER- Terry Campus Hawks lacrosse team scored another win on Wednesday, April 22 ending the game 8-6 over host Brookdale Community College (NJ). This win locked up the top seed for the Hawks in NJCAA Region XIX with a 3-0 record for the season.

This weekend, the Region XIX Tournament will be held at Williamson Free School in Media, PA. Delaware Tech men's squad will take on Morris County (NJ) in their first game of the four-team tournament on Saturday at 2:00 p.m.

According to the team's coach, John Coveleski, the Hawks season has shown not only growth and development of the Delaware Tech lacrosse program, but has realized several standout individual players. Goalie Mike McGuigan is ranked in the top three nationally for saves, Scott Brozey is ranked in top ten for goals scored; and Tyler Fry, Nate Gorski and Brynn Weidenmann are recognized on the NJCAA list for over all points. Wednesday night's game included two goals each for Ed Heckman and Scott Brozey and goals from Wes Barnes and Zecariah Rodgers. Goalie Mike McGuigan added 12 more saves to his already stellar record.

The Region XIX champion will face the champion of Region III to decide who plays in the national semifinals. Delaware Tech, Terry Campus has an overall record of 6-8.
