

Placement Testing

Delaware Tech uses the College Board's ACCUPLACER Computerized Placement Tests (CPTs) to provide information about your skill levels in reading, English, and mathematics. This information is used to help determine the integrated reading and writing/English, and mathematics courses that are most appropriate for you at this time. For students for whom English is a second language, there is also a component called the LOEP (Levels of English Proficiency). All tests are untimed and on the computer.

Do You Need to Take the Accuplacer Placement Test?

YES

- If you have never taken the SAT
- If you have never attended college before and
- If you have SAT Verbal scores below 475 and
- If you have math SAT scores below 500.

MAYBE NOT

- If you have a transcript that shows completion of some credit level English, Reading, and Math courses
- You have previously taken the ACCUPLACER CPT
- If you have a math SAT score equal to or above 500

DEFINITELY NOT

- If you have a SAT Verbal score equal to or above 475
- If you have a Bachelor's degree and a college-level credit math course.
