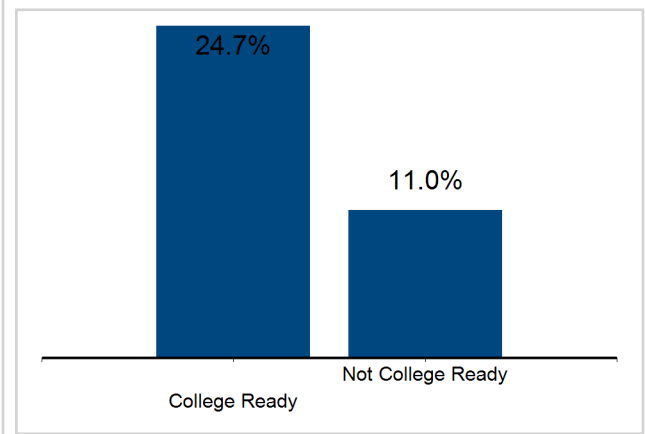
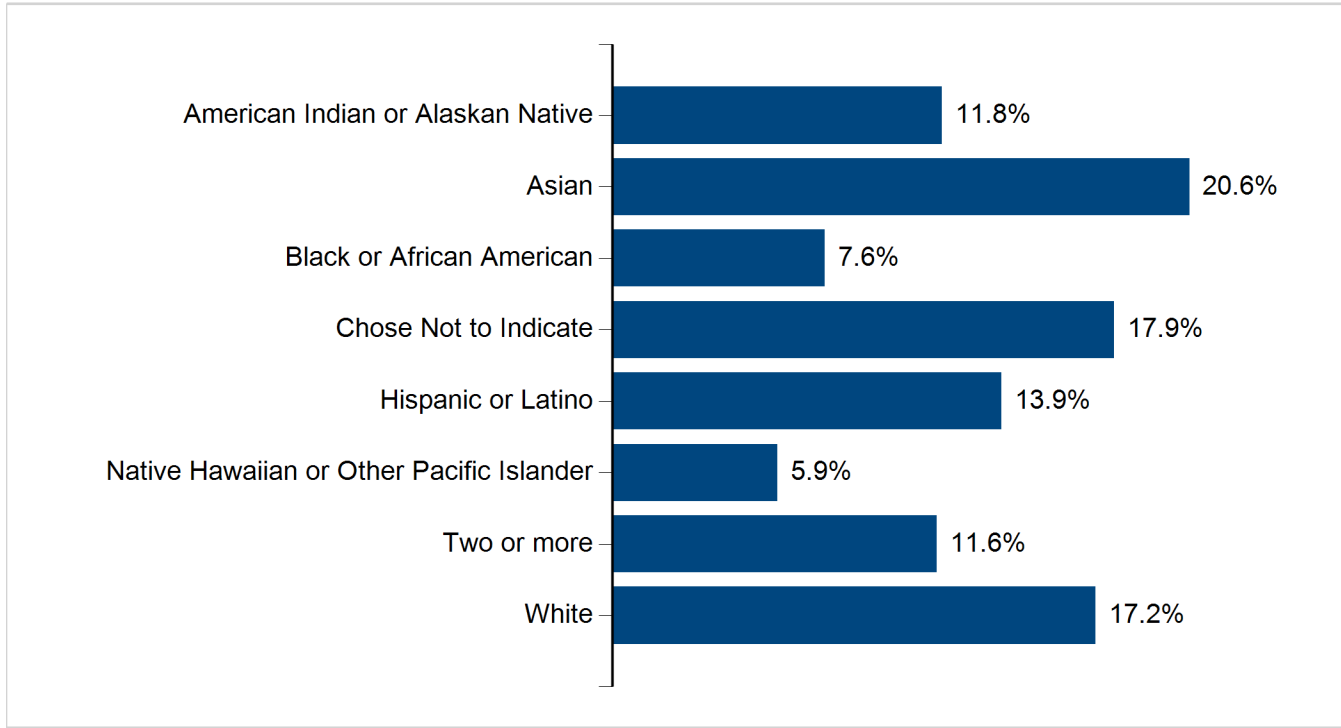
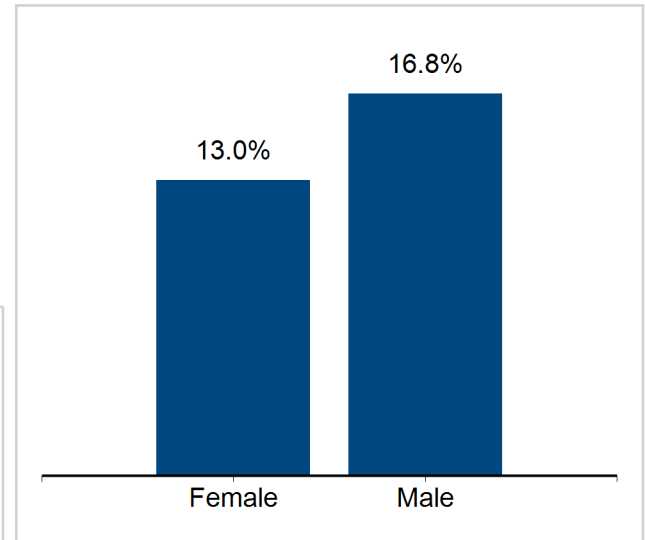

College Ready - Students are considered fully qualified if they test at the college level in Math, Reading and English. These students require no developmental courses to begin their degree program.

Not College Ready - Students are considered not fully qualified if they test into developmental math, reading and English. Students' placement is determined by their performance on the Accuplacer or other aptitude test.
