**Credentialing Examination Pass Rate**

The number of student graduates who pass, on the first attempt, the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) examination, compared with the number of graduates who take the examination within six months of graduation.

**Job Placement Rate**

The number of graduates employed in radiography within twelve months of graduation compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.

**Program Completion Rate**

The number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length compared with the number of students who initially started with the cohort.
